Conference of Parties (COP24) to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), Katowice, Poland

An initiative of the African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) Group of States, the Intra-ACP Global Climate Change Alliance Plus (GCCA+) Programme supports ACP countries' efforts to address climate change.

Since the inception of the first phase in 2011, the initiative has worked with many ACP member states, strengthening dialogue and cooperation on climate change with the most vulnerable developing countries.

Funded by the 11th European Development Fund (EDF), the €70 million Intra-ACP GCCA+ Programme specifically targets ACP Member States, helping them to better tackle climate change as a challenge to their development and implement appropriate adaptation and mitigation responses.

It finances regional programmes managed by ACP regional organisations, and it also includes a technical assistance component, the Climate Support Facility (CSF), to provide demand-driven technical support.
